**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. **Entry to the event is \$50** and must be submitted together with the nomination form to the Show Secretary. There will be **no refunds** once the nomination is accepted. The event is limited to the first 40 vehicles.
2. All vehicles to be parked by 5pm Saturday in the designated area where they will be inspected.  
Event to take place approximately 9pm in the Main Showground Arena.
3. All drivers must be 17 years of age or over and be the holder of a current N.S.W. Drivers License
4. All Cars must be of average sedan size and includes utes and station wagons but not including HQ, HZ, HX, HJ and WB Holdens.
5. No four-wheel drive or chassied vehicles allowed.
6. The vehicle must be its original height, i.e. no alteration to the suspension.
7. There must be no internal or external, extra reinforcement or bar work except as stated in Rule 8.
8. **For driver protection** an A frame must be fitted as in diagram A but may be substituted by the frame in Diagram B. The fitting of either one or other frame from diagram A or B is compulsory.
9. No other forms of welding or plating other than Rule 8 on the engine mounting.  
All glass must be removed from vehicle, including dashboard glass, headlights and tail lights and all loose glass in door panels or interior of vehicle must be vacuumed out. Interior rear vision mirror is allowed.
10. Engine to be in original position
11. All doors must be welded and strapped closed using one inch by quarter inch metal strapping or be bolted.
12. All cars must carry a fire extinguisher
13. All vehicles must have brakes.
14. Seat belts or racing harness in good condition, crash helmets and racing uniform must be worn.
15. Vehicles must not contain rust in seat or seat belt mountings.
16. A limit of five (5) litres of petrol only is allowed.
17. A five (5)-litre can with screw top cap must be fastened to the centre rear of the vehicle.
18. Fuel tanks to be removed or complete tops or bottoms to be cut out.
19. The original fuel line must be used with grommets where it passes through firewall.
20. Tow-bar and tongue to be removed.
21. Mesh must be fitted to driver's side window.
22. Mesh covering windscreen area is optional.
23. Radiator must be in original position but fan blades may be removed.
24. The Show Steward will supply each driver with a flag attached to a piece of dowel. The flag is to be attached to the vehicle near the driver's window. When he is unable to continue in the event, he snaps the flag off. He cannot re-enter the event and must not be deliberately hit by any other vehicle once the flag is broken.
25. Bonnet and boot to be pinned or bolted shut (not welded) but must be able to be visually inspected for scrutinising.
26. Removal of seat belt, safety harness or helmet during the event incurs immediate disqualification.
27. All vehicles to be fitted with effective muffler.
28. The driver's name must be displayed on the right-hand side of the roof (150mm)
29. The two front doors to be reserved for the names of the sponsors.
30. Each Vehicle to be numbered, the number to be displayed on the roof similar to Speedway Cars (300mm x 400mm). Numbers to be allocated on receipt of nominations.
31. The batteries must have a rubber cover securely bolted over the top. It may be fitted in the cabin area and cable must have grommets where it passes through firewall.
32. An area will be marked on the ground with lime to show the boundary of the area to be used and any vehicle driving over this boundary line shall be eliminated from the event.
33. All vehicles to be inspected before the commencement of the event.
34. All drivers must remain in their vehicles until the event is completed.
35. Any vehicle deliberately ramming the driver's door will be disqualified from the event.
36. No one is permitted to deliberately hit a stationary vehicle.
37. Drivers are allowed to use low and reverse gears only and can travel a maximum of 40 metres at any time in a straight line.
38. No driver under the influence of alcohol will be permitted to compete.
39. All vehicles must be removed from the Showground following the completion of the event or a \$50 fine will be imposed on the driver for not doing so.
40. The Judges reserve the right to disqualify any driver at any time.
41. The Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
42. The Armidale & New England Show Society Inc. accepts no responsibility for any personal injury to any driver or damage to any vehicle taking part in the Demolition Derby.
43. Competitors must complete appropriate documentation and obtain wristband

**1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes to be given plus best presented car.**

**Note: Drivers not wearing wristbands will not be permitted to compete**
