The aim of the contest is to find the young lady most fitted to represent Rural New South Wales during her term as "The Land" Royal Easter Showgirl.

All Single girls between 18 & 24 are invited to participate in the Showgirl Competition

All Teenage girls between 15 & 17 are invited to enter the Teen Showgirl Competition.

Entries Close February 26th, 2010

Armidale Show Society is seeking intelligent, articulate, well-mannered young ladies with friendly, outgoing personalities. They will be able to talk confidently about Armidale, the New England region, and the general Australian scene, illustrating her own thoughts on a variety of topics.

Entrants are interviewed individually, in an informal atmosphere, by a panel of three Judges from outside the district. Entrants are judged on their personality, knowledge, social skills, and grooming. As part of the selection process the entrants enjoy a meal with the judges, the Show President, and organizing committee.

The winner of the Showgirl Competition will be required to attend the Zone Finals in 2011. Two equal winners from the Zone Finals will then represent the Zone in the State Judging of "The Land" Showgirl at the Royal Easter Show in Sydney the same year.

To qualify entrants must be local* to Armidale, over 18 years of age on 1st May 2010, under 25 years of age as at 1 May 2011.

Teen Showgirl entrants to be aged between 15 and 17 on 1st January 2010.

* The RAS defines 'local' as having strong family, work or educational connections to the nominating town.

Winners will be announced at the Armidale Show official opening.
